



ADAPTDX PRO POWER MANAGEMENT

Power supply management for the AdaptDx Pro[®] is vital to consistent trouble-free testing

- The AdaptDx Pro system comes with two handheld controllers
- Each controller has a rechargeable battery which provides power to the headset
- A charged controller must be connected to the headset at all times, even when stored

THE OTHER CONTROLLER SHOULD BE LEFT ON THE WALL CHARGER UNTIL SWAPPED FOR THE DEPLETED ONE ON THE HEADSET

Helpful Hint:

- Exchange the controller attached to the headset for the one on the wall charger after each use.
- Alternating one handheld controller for another routinely throughout the day will ensure a fully charged headset for each new test.

WHEN ATTACHING A CONTROLLER TO THE HEADSET,
MAKE SURE THE CORD IS FIRMLY SEATED INTO THE USB
RECEPTACLES, THEN PRESS THE CENTER BUTTON TO
ACTIVATE THE INDICATOR LIGHT.

CONTROLLER INDICATOR LIGHTS

Solid Green = Full Power

Controller ready for use

Flashing Green = Low Power

Enough power for one test

Flashing Amber = Very Low Power -

Not enough power to test
