

Age-related macular degeneration (AMD) is the leading cause of adult vision loss in the US, affecting:

in 1 in 8 over age 60



1 in 3 over age 75

Trouble seeing or driving at night is the earliest symptom of AMD. Risk factors include:

- Age 50 or older
- Family history of AMD
- Caucasian (white)
- Smoker or past smoker
- Being overweight
- Heart disease; high blood pressure or cholesterol
